

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 05 of 2015

Update to Wreck at Entrance to Littlehampton Harbour

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that the previously reported wreck at the entrance to Littlehampton Harbour has now been marked with a pink spherical buoy.

The buoy is in position 50° 47.81'N, 000° 32.82' W, approximately 150m south east of the Eastern Beacon at the entrance to Littlehampton Harbour and marks an abandoned 28ft sailing vessel that is now breaking up on Littlehampton East Beach.

The vessel is visible at low tide and covered at high water.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
