

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 06 of 2015

Further Update to Wreck at Entrance to Littlehampton Harbour

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that the previously reported wreck at the entrance to Littlehampton Harbour (and marked with a pink buoy in position 50° 47.81'N, 000° 32.82'W) has now been marked with a second yellow spherical buoy with the word WRECK in black letters.

The vessel has started to break up and lies in two main sections. Mariners are advised to keep 15m clear of both the pink and yellow buoys marking the positions of this wreckage.

The keel/rudder section and bow of the vessel are visible at low tide and covered at high water.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
