

LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 09 of 2015


Armed Forces Day Temporary Marks off Littlehampton Harbour

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that temporary pink marker buoys have been placed in the vicinity of East beach for the Armed forces day on Saturday 27th June 2015.

An aerial display will take place within view of East Beach between 1500 – 1600 hours. The aircraft will fly at low heights and carry out aerobatics for display purposes.

Mariners are requested to keep clear and outside of the red boundary as pictured and 400m south of the line of buoys when at sea. The Littlehampton Harbour Patrol vessel will be afloat throughout the display and listening on VHF Ch 71 +16.

Cancel this LNtM on recovery of the marks on or after 29th June 2015.
