



LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 04 of 2016

Arundel Quayside Wall Collapse – Update

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that following completion of emergency wall stabilisation and flood defence works carried out by the Environment Agency and West Sussex Fire and Rescue Service at River Road in Arundel, a significant part of the quay wall at River Road **between the A27 Arundel Bypass bridge and the Old Arundel bridge in the town centre** at Queen Street and the High Street remains in a **weakened condition or has collapsed**.

Debris in the river is marked by a yellow spherical buoy, in position 50° 51.17'N, 000° 33.39'W which is unlit.

This section of the harbour should be navigated at DEAD SLOW and with NO WASH until further notice.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
